All the hymns this morning are by prolific Moravian hymnwriter James Montgomery, and we shall hear some of his exciting and challenging stories opposing the slave trade and child labor in the sermon.

The Call to Worship, It Is A Precious Thing was written here in Salem by Johann Friedrich Peter, who was music director of the community from 1780-1790. After leaving Salem, he served in Graceham, Maryland, Hope, New Jersev, and Bethlehem, Pennsylvania.

The anthem, I Came to Jesus As I Was was written by Trinity member Mozelle Petree in 1972, with music composed by Henry Phfol Highsmith, also a Trinity member.

Next Sunday, May 1, the music will be provided by the Trinity Ringers.
